He was offered a position at Queen's University teaching political science by James Corry who later became principal of Queen's, but turned it down because he preferred to teach in Quebec. Though winning the popular vote by four points, the Liberal vote was concentrated. He was disliked by the Quebecois nationalists. While thought-provoking books about Pierre Elliott Trudeau abound, it is only with the recent release of his personal papers that it has become possible to craft a more thorough biography of the charismatic, bilingual, and controversial man who served as Canada's prime minister from 1968 to 1982.
