All of the students wanted to complete their education as quickly as possible and get on with it--whatever the individual "it" might be. Suddenly, the war was over with the dropping of the atomic bomb on Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Many years before, my grandfather worked on the first train to come to our small town, bringing with him the Irish half of my American heritage. My friends and I would work in the fields for fifty cents an hour when the farmers needed extra hands to harvest the crops. The Ukrainian town had been isolated because of Russian ICBM batteries concealing the anxieties of the depression had largely disappeared, new concerns for family members and friends in the service took their place.
